A. FY 2017 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Update

Four submittals totaling approximately \$1.2M were received under the FY 2017 TAP Call for Projects, which closed at the end of January. The FY 2017 TAP Call for Projects identified the potential for funding to be broadened to include FY 2018 TAP funds so that appropriate proposals submitted for, but not funded by, the FY 2017 TAP might be programmed in FY 2018; the review team decided to exercise this option. Staff will update the TAC on the results of proposal reviews, selection method, and outline the path forward in the award process. (See attached memo)

B. FY 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) Update / 2015-2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) Amendment

The MPO is in the midst of a two-year cycle update of its four-year plan, the TIP. MPO staff have been working with the TAC to re-evaluate project prioritization and project scopes on the MPO's long-range plan, the MTP, to inform project prioritization on the updated TIP.
