### **A. Draft FY 2017 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)**

The UPWP describes transportation planning priorities and related activities to be performed during the year by the MPO and partner entities and identifies who will perform the work, the schedule for completing it, and the expected products. The process for developing the UPWP includes addressing federally mandated planning factors as well as prioritizing planning emphasis areas identified yearly by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration.
