**A. MPO Title VI Policies and Plan Update - 2016.**

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI) ensures that no person shall on the grounds of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, age or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subject to discrimination. As a recipient of Federal Financial Assistance, the MPO must consider Title VI in all phases of planning. To certify continued compliance with Title VI, MPO staff has updated its policies and plan. This update included development of:

- Title VI Policy Statement in Spanish
- Expanded plan narrative (attachment)
- Tri-annual work plan and proposed
- Tri-annual accomplishments report

Staff presents this opportunity to brief the TAC on the efforts undertaken to update the MPO's Title VI Policies and Plan and is seeking recommendation by the TAC for Transportation Policy Committee (TPC) approval the Title VI 2016 Plan Update.
