A. Aligning TxDOT's 10 Year Unified Transportation Plan to MPO Plans

Pursuant to HB 20, as enacted by the 84th Legislature, each MPO shall develop a 10-year transportation plan for use of the funding allocated to the region. Staff provide this opportunity to update the TAC on the background of HB 20, implications for the MPO, and next steps.

B. Category 4 Planning Targets

MPO staff present this opportunity to update TAC members on anticipated Category 4 allocation and candidate projects.

4. Discussion and Possible Action:

A. Title VI Policy Statement

As a recipient of Federal financial assistance and under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the MPO has revised the Title VI Policy Statement to clarify the organization's commitment to nondiscrimination. MPO staff is seeking recommendation by the TAC for TPC approval of the updated Title VI Policy Statement.

B. Proposed Prop 1 Project (US 181 overpass at Kay Bailey Hutchison Road) Update

On Nov. 4, 2014, Texas voters overwhelmingly approved the ballot measure known as Proposition 1 (Prop 1), authorizing a constitutional amendment for transportation funding. Under the amendment, a portion of oil and gas tax revenues that typically go into the Economic Stabilization Fund are being deposited to the State Highway Fund. MPO staff present this item to provide an opportunity to update the TAC on project status and critical path milestones for successful implementation.
