The UPWP also serves as the operating budget for the MPO. The process for developing the UPWP includes addressing federally mandated planning factors as well as prioritizing planning emphasis areas identified yearly by the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration. Per Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) recommendation, MPO staff is seeking approval by the TPC to submit the Draft FY 2017 UPWP to TxDOT for review. (Please see attached memo)
