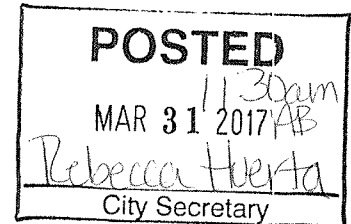

A. US 181 Harbor Bridge Project Update

Flatiron/Dragados LLC (FDLLC), the developer for the US 181 Harbor Bridge project, will update the TPC on the latest project developments.

5. Discussion and Possible Action:

A. Congestion Management Process (CMP)

The CMP is, per federal definition, a systematic process that provides safe and effective integrated management and operation of the multimodal transportation system. A CMP is required in metropolitan areas with population exceeding 200,000, known as Transportation Management Areas (TMAs). As a TMA, the MPO is updating the CMP to serve as the organizing framework for all transportation planning activities in our metro area. Per a recommendation by the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC), staff is seeking TPC approval of the updated Congestion Management Process (attached).

A. FY 2018 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Updates

Staff has drafted the FY 2018 UPWP, which is the MPO's shortest-term planning document (one year) and doubles as the operating budget for the organization. State and federal guidance to date suggests level funding from FY 2017. Staff presents this opportunity to introduce the TPC to the Draft FY 2018 UPWP (attached) and to discuss the proposed FY 2018 budget prior to its submittal to TxDOT. MPO staff will request TPC approval of the draft UPWP in May.

B. FY 2017 Prop 1 Project Update

Staff present this opportunity to update the TPC on the US 181 Overpass Project at Kay Bailey Hutchison Road.
