Texas' First Segment Of Interstate 69

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) - Corpus Christi District unveiled the first I-69 highway signs during an event held on Dec 5th. While the cold weather was readily noted, it did not deter many from attending the unveiling. The I-69 signs will mark the first six mile segment of the newly designated Interstate 69 situated in Robstown, Texas from State Highway 44 to Interstate 37.

TxDOT District Engineer John A. Casey introduced federal, state and local dignitaries and others that have been instrumental in the fruition of this project.
