We have reviewed the Corpus Christi Metropolitan Planning Organization's (CCMPO) August 7th Amendment to the Unified Planning Work Program (FY 2025 & FY 2026) - Amendment 1 as electronically received from TPP on October 23, 2025; as clarified on January 9, 2026. Based on our review we offer the following:

1. The following revisions, as funded with Transportation Planning Funds (TPF), comprised of FHWA PL 112 and FTA Section 5303 funding, are approved:
 - Subtask 2.2- Reducing travel demand modeling by \$17,000 for a total of \$30,800
 - Subtask 3.1- Reducing Transportation Improvement by \$5,000 for a total of \$49,200
 - Subtask 3.2-Reducing CMP/TSMO/ITS Coordination Plan \$5,000 for a total of \$24,700
 - Subtask 3.3- Adding 2.5% Set Aside for Increasing Safe and Accessible Transportation Options \$78,000 for a total of \$98,900.
 - Subtask 3.5-Reducing Regional Demographics Planning by \$5,000 for a total of \$17,100
 - Subtask 3.6-Reducing Economic Analysis of Projects and Portfolios by \$5,000 for a total of \$30,300
 - Subtask 3.8 Reducing crash analysis by \$10,000 for a total of \$23,200
 - Subtask 3.10 Reducing Regional Resiliency and Climate Crisis Planning by \$5,000 for a total of \$24,200

- Subtask 3.11 Reducing Planning and Environmental Linkages by \$5,000 for a total of \$30,200.
