The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) personnel have been working closely with the Corpus Christi Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to complete the Transportation Management Area (TMA) certification review process required under Title 23 United States Code (USC) 134(k) and 23 CFR 450.334(b).

This letter serves as formal notification that the review of the Corpus Christi MPO's metropolitan transportation planning process, conducted from October 26-28, 2021, has now been completed. We are pleased to inform you that, after a thorough evaluation of the MPO's metropolitan transportation planning process, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have determined that the MPO meets the requirements outlined in 23 CFR 450 (highway) and 49 CFR Part 613 (transit). Please find attached a copy of the final TMA Certification Report, which highlights commendations, as well as recommended areas for improvement. This report is presented for informational purposes only and does not require action by the regional planning partners. The team looks forward to the certification review for 2025, which will take place later this year.
