

Announcement: Federal Certification Review

Corpus Christi Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO)

The U.S. Department of Transportation (FHWA Texas Division and FTA Region 6) will conduct a Federal Certification Review of the Corpus Christi Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) planning process on February 11–13, 2026. The review evaluates the MPO's metropolitan planning process under 23 U.S.C. § 134 and 23 CFR Part 450.

Purpose

- Confirm the MPO's planning process is continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive (the “3C” process)
- Review key plans and procedures, including the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP), Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), performance-based planning and programming, public involvement and consultation, and the Congestion Management Process.
- Identify strengths, share best practices, and recommend improvements if needed.

Why This Matters

This review helps ensure the Corpus Christi region's transportation plans support safe, efficient, and performance-driven investments, and it strengthens coordination among the MPO, TxDOT, CCRTA, local transit providers, cities, counties, and the public.
